Meeting Started: 7:03 p.m.

1. After the Pledge of Allegiance, President Suzanne Wycoff gave an introduction greeting and mentioned how nice it would be to have students present at the meeting and to have them sing our National Anthem.
2. President Wycoff discuss the upcoming musical (Beauty and the Beast) and the many volunteers needed to serve and donate to food services. The deadline for placing program ads is 3/1/18. She also wanted to thank everyone who came out to wrap presents.
5. Food Services chair Michele Delello spoke about needs for the upcoming tech week for Beauty and the Beast. Volunteers are needed. All the details will be in the sign up genius. Parents are welcome to donate money instead of actual food items.

6. It was noted that the sign up genius would also include sign ups for helping with apparel, 50/50, Kiss the Cast and all other functions over the course of the show weekend.

7. It was noted that Mrs. Faist again requested PTSO contribution for the dancer's trip to Pittsburgh in the amount of \$250.00. There were no oppositions to this contribution being made.
